

Dear Home Owner,

January 2011

We are writing to encourage you to make your plans for hurricane season. If you rent your property we are asking you to make plans for your rental property as well

While we all hope for good weather this season, we want to encourage you to plan for preparations for a storm and the potential evacuation that would be possible in the case of a severe storm.

1. Complete a Family Hurricane Plan – A form developed by the Lee County Emergency Operations Center can be found online on our website [www.mycaptiva.info](http://www.mycaptiva.info), the CCA and CPOA web sites and at the Captiva library and Fire Station.
2. Get a hurricane pass. Your 2009 pass is good this year. You will need it to re-enter the island after an evacuation. You can find instructions on [www.mycaptiva.info](http://www.mycaptiva.info) and [www.mysanibel.com](http://www.mysanibel.com).
3. Register anyone you would like authorized to check your house after an evacuation with the Resident Sheriff Deputies on Captiva by sending a signed letter to the attention of: Captiva Resident Sheriff Deputies c/o Captiva Fire Control District, P.O. Box 477, Captiva, FL 33924. Send a copy to the people who you are authorizing to enter your property.
4. If you rent through an agency. Check their plans for informing and evacuating renters. If you rent yourself, we recommend you inform renters to do the following during a storm
  - a. Listen to local media before and during a storm for instructions.
  - b. Watch Lee County TV (cable channel 11 on Captiva) for information and instructions.
  - c. Watch the Captiva Fire Station flagpole. If an evacuation is ordered, a red flag will be flown.

Most importantly, keep your family and possessions safe during hurricane season.
